# PERFORMANCE

#### Museum Tours to the Egyptian Museum

An interactive tour that contests currently predominant narratives enacted by the museum and interacts with it as a site and body of collective and nationalist memory. The tours focus on our bodies and feelings within the museum.

#### 2021- ongoing: Re-imaging Egyptology Program

Curation of a pedagogical space discussing potential (hi)stories and para-fiction.

#### 2021- 2023: Momentum, Yet Eternal Mirage

A participatory performance that discusses the relation of gender to photography aesthetics and the different ways of seeing. Through one-on-one intimate performances with around 17 different artists, anthropologists, and cultural workers in different spaces in Cairo, such as parks, rooftops, and my studio. Usually while sharing food, we collectively explored photographs as (in)animate objects, while experimenting with how space influences this collective exploration. **In addition to:**

#### 2023: Finding Our Feet
